



St. Matthias Parishioners,

We are excited to announce that St. Matthias has partnered with **ParishSoft Giving** in order to provide you with the convenience of **online contributions**. This system replaces the myEoffering system that our parish had been using.


Online contributions are much like online bill pay where parishioners can choose to have their financial contributions to St. Matthias withdrawn directly from their credit, debit, checking or savings account in lieu of bringing cash or checks to church each Sunday. This can include your regular weekly offertory envelope, second collections, and capital campaign contributions.

ParishSoft Giving has designed a secure, web-based platform in which donors may privately and prayerfully make one-time or recurring donations. You can customize a completely individual method of giving based on how and when you receive your income – whether it be bi-weekly, monthly, or semi-monthly. By setting up recurring donations to be automatically deducted from your account or credit card, you don't have to prepare envelopes each week before you come to Mass and it helps our parish to better plan budgets and expenditures through a more accurate financial forecast.

You can select from two available methods below to make donations to St. Matthias:


- 1) Direct debit from your bank checking or savings account or,
- 2) Via a credit or debit card

For recurring donations under **“Scheduled Giving”**, once you select either option 1 or option 2, all of your scheduled gifts to different funds to St. Matthias are processed using that option. The system does not allow for some scheduled gifts to be made from a bank account and others from a credit or debit card.

When making a one-time donation using **“Give Now”**, you can select either of the above options regardless of which option you are using for your scheduled gifts.

If you plan to make donations via direct debit from your bank checking or savings account (referred to as **“eCheck / ACH”**), setup the link to your bank account using this  symbol in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.

Complete the fields on the screen below and click on **“Authorize”** when done. Be sure to click on the check signature line to sign the check. You can also select a fund if you are doing a one-time donation under **“Give Now”**.

You can either do a one-time donation by clicking on **“Give Now”** or setup a scheduled, recurring donation by clicking on **“Scheduled Giving”** which will display the screen below.

You can add donations for additional funds by clicking on “**Click Here to add an additional schedule**”. Once activated, each active schedule can be selected and edited as desired.

Each time a donation is processed, you will receive a thank you email from Fr. Chris with the subject “Online Donation.” The email will include the amount of your gift, the fund that was credited and an indication that the transaction was successful. You can save these for your records and compare to the bank account or credit card statements for accuracy.

You can update your profile information by clicking on “My Account” which will display the following screen. This screen also shows your giving history.

Payment options for ParishSoft Giving include credit cards, and either a checking or savings account. St. Matthias pays a much smaller fee for donations using direct debit from your bank account than for donations using credit cards. If you chose to contribute by using a credit, there is option on the screen “**Add 3% to cover costs of processing.**” If you check this box, 3% will be added to your donation to help offset the processing fees that would have otherwise been charged to the parish.

We invite you to try electronic contributions and we hope you find it very convenient. You can use any computer and variety of web browsers. If you don’t have access to a computer but would still like your offerings to be deducted from your account, contact the parish office to arrange a time to come into the office and a staff member will help setup your electronic offering.
